April 2015 – 60 wks 5 days

All producers are reminded to keep a close watch on fertility and to spike accordingly. All producers should aim to have their flocks reach the 60 weeks. Remember to heavily cull eggs towards the end of you flock to keep your hatch up.

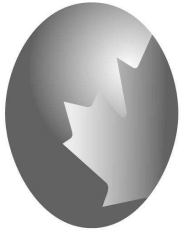
