**TO ALL REGISTERED B.C. HATCHERIES**

**RE: COLLECTING LEVIES ON TEMPORARILY REGULARIZED PRODUCER CHICK QUOTA**

Effective September 19, 2019, the BC Broiler Hatching Egg Commission allotted Temporarily Regularized Producer Chick Quota to Asian Breeder Producers.

Per Amending Order 22, this allotment is subject to a levy at a rate of \$0.015 per Saleable Chick. All hatcheries that throughput Asian Breeder product must collect and remit on the Producers' behalf the levies, plus GST, on a weekly basis to the Commission. This process is to mirror the way mainstream production is levied and remitted.

The Asian Breeder Weekly Report contains a section for hatch results. Hatcheries may use this tab to populate the required levy and GST or prepare a separate report.

As a reminder, the levy is applicable to saleable chicks not just placed chicks. Weekly reporting and levy remitting are required as a condition of licensing.
