All BC Hatching Egg Producers and Stakeholders,

**RE: PROPOSED HATCHERY LICENSE CRITERIA CHANGES EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 31, 2021
FOLLOW-UP**

The BC Broiler Hatching Egg Commission has received preliminary feedback from some stakeholders to the letter dated May 3, 2021. Specifically, one Producer-Hatchery has requested to review the Official Flock Schedule.

As outlined in section 20 of the Consolidated Order:


The Official Flock Schedule is available for inspection at the Office of the Commission during regular business hours, provided that the Commission may withhold information from the Official Flock Schedule that does not pertain to the Person requesting inspection.

With respect to the current COVID-19 pandemic, the Commission has prepared a package specific to each Producer-Hatchery which contains both hatchery placement order sheets, and actual production graphs (egg pickups). These are provided for the years 2020, 2021 and 2022. These will be sent separately to each Producer-Hatchery only to maintain confidentiality.

We understand that with this new information it may provide additional insight and feedback to the Commission, originally requested by June 10, 2021. Therefore, we ask that any further stakeholder feedback be received by July 31, 2021 in accordance with separate correspondence extending the feedback period. Again, this feedback will be carefully considered by the Commission before reaching any decisions with respect to the proposed Amending Order.
