### **IMPLEMENTATION OF NEW PRICING FRAMEWORK FOR BC HATCHING EGG SECTOR**

In its June 3, 2022, decision, the BC Farm Industry Review Board (BCFIRB) provided the BC Broiler Hatching Egg Commission (the Commission) with the authority to commence implementing its proposed new pricing framework for the BC hatching egg sector.

In that decision, BCFIRB also gave the Commission the discretion as to which Period it would implement that change. BCFIRB also required the Commission to provide stakeholders with one Period's notice.


In its proposal, the Commission was targeting implementation for Period A-178, commencing August 28, 2022.

The Commission has been preparing an implementation plan for discussion at its board meeting on June 23, 2022. One consideration is to defer implementation until Period A-179, commencing October 23, 2022, to provide more time to finalize implementation preparations. This is particularly important right now because of the involvement of affected stakeholders in managing AI. Equally important to the Commission is the hope that the people with this extraordinary workload will have opportunity for some rest and relaxation over the summer.

The Commission's Pricing and Production Advisory Committee supported this deferment at its June 16, 2022, meeting.

The Commission will confirm its decision on implementation timing at its June 23, 2022, meeting. If anyone has any issues or questions they wish to have considered, please forward those to the Commission office by Wednesday, June 22, 2022.
